## DISCOVERY ZONE

During July and August, The Children's House Montessori enhances its Montessori curriculum with a unique, fun, skill-building program with exciting weekly themes that allow children to explore and discover a wide variety of topics and ideas. This all-inclusive program, run by qualified, trained and certified educators, will include a host of special activities and/or field trips.

### WEEK 1 - GROWING OUR GARDEN

### WEEK 2 - MAD SCIENCE WITH MISS KATIE

Acting is very physical. Participate in gross motor activities through skits and warm up games. Create your own performance. At the end of the week, perform at the talent show!

### WEEK 5 - MONTESSORI TOP CHEF

Did you know you can make bread and ice cream in a bag? Toss and shake the bag with help from your teammates until the cream turns solid. Experience other culinary experiments and taste the fruits of your labour.

### WEEK 6 - A TRIP THROUGH TIME

### WEEK 7 - BACKYARD OLYMPIANS
